TERMS of USE – NPSS School Bus Service

OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Students are to be at their particular stop at least 5 minutes before the scheduled bus time to allow for variation in traffic conditions as well as to ensure the safety of the children. Parents of very young children are requested to be waiting at the bus stop to collect their children unless a responsible older child accompanies them.

EXTREME WEATHER CONDITIONS

When extreme weather conditions prevail, and roads become impassable, it may be considered to be in the best interests of all to close the school for the entire day. In this event, a message will be placed on the school Facebook page, parents will receive an SMS and email, if possible, a message will be broadcast over the local radio station.

BUS FEES

Bus Fees will be charged on a term basis and added to parent accounts. They are to be paid by the first week of each term, in addition to any Direct Debit or payment plan arrangement in place for school fees and levies.

CODE OF CONDUCT – SAFE BUS TRAVEL BEHAVIOUR

BEHAVIOUR	EXAMPLES OF HOW TO FOLLOW THE CODE
Respect other people and property.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Treat other people and their possessions with respect • Follow the bus driver's directions without argument • Do not cause damage to the bus in any way
Wait for the bus in an orderly manner.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wait well back from the bus until it stops and allow passengers to leave the bus first • Stand quietly without calling out or shouting • Do not push other people in the line
Whilst on the bus, conduct yourself in an appropriate and orderly manner.	<p>STUDENTS SHOULD:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Always follow instructions from the driver about safety on the bus • Sit properly on a seat if one is available (in an allocated seat if directed by the driver) • Not stand on any bus when it is moving • Store school bags under the seat or in appropriate luggage areas • Speak quietly using appropriate language and not create unnecessary noise • Wear a seat belt, where fitted <p>STUDENTS SHOULD NOT:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bully other students • Place feet on the seat • Fight, spit or use offensive language • Throw any article around or from the bus • Consume food or drink, or play music (using portable devices) • Allow any part of their body to protrude out of bus windows • Distract the driver in any way
Use designated stops.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Get on and off the bus at the correct designated stop
When getting off the bus, do so in an orderly manner.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wait until the bus stops before standing to get off • Get off the bus in a quiet and orderly fashion • When you get off the bus, take two (2) big steps away from the bus • Never cross the road in front of or behind the bus; wait until the bus has moved away and it is safe to cross the road • Use crossings or traffic lights if available
In case of a breakdown, follow the driver's directions.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wait until the bus stops before standing to get off • Leave the bus in a quiet and orderly fashion • Wait in the area indicated by the driver
<p>DANGER: If you can touch the bus, the driver cannot see you and you are in danger.</p>
