

Schedule of Fees 2023

Effective from 1 January 2023

Enrolment Application Fee

The Enrolment Application fee of \$220 (GST included) per child is paid once the application is lodged and is non-refundable. This fee covers the administrative cost of enrolment and the **initial** interview. The enrolment process will commence once the application fee is paid.

Enrolment Confirmation Fee

The Enrolment Confirmation Fee of \$600.00 per child is non-refundable and holds a position for the child in the class. Enrolment confirmation is subject to payment of the confirmation fee. Your enrolment process is complete when the enrolment confirmation fee has been received.

The Enrolment Confirmation Fee covers the administration costs associated with processing your child's application. This involves registering and reviewing your child's documents, organising and holding interviews with the Class Teachers and School Principal, evaluation of your child's needs and the suitability of the school to your child. This also covers the annual preparation and submission of student data to the government so that we can receive funding and keep the tuition fees at a reasonable level to be able to provide your child with a quality education and resources.

Building Levy

The Building Levy is not subject to discount or refund. **The full levy will be charged to families that enrol at any time throughout the year.** This levy will not be refunded if you withdraw your enrolment from the school at any time during the year. The Building Levy assists in the construction, renovation, extension and maintenance of buildings and other educational facilities and equipment (e.g. desks, library, technology), which are essential to enable the provision of quality education. These funds form an integral component of the School's Budget and Financial operations. The levy is charged once per family each year regardless of when the family enrolls throughout the year.

Steiner Education Australia Levy

Steiner Education Australia is the peak body for Australian Steiner schools and advocate, promote, support and represent member schools Australia-wide. The SEA Levy is charged per child and is not subject to discount or refund. The full levy applies to students enrolled at any time during the year.

Tuition Fees

Tuition fees include tuition for the compulsory primary instrumental music program from Class 3 to Class 7, most camps, learn to swim, and an allowance for general classroom materials.

The tuition fee does not cover items such as musical instruments, pencil boxes, clothes, hats, lunches, or instrument hire. Note that recorders are purchased for students in Class 1 and used for the duration of primary schooling. The charge for this will be added to accounts during the year.

In exceptional circumstances, the costs of excursions, camps and transport are charged out at cost on a user pays basis.

Tuition fees will be charged quarterly at the beginning of each term. The Building Levy and SEA Levy fees are charged annually at the beginning of the school year and are payable with the first term fees.

Preschool

All Preschool families will receive a rebate of \$1,500 on tuition fees through the new 2023 Queensland Kindergarten Funding model. The rebate will be applied quarterly to accounts (\$375 credited each term). Further rebates may be applicable for eligible families. Fees for Preschool families are required to be paid in full and any rebates will be applied as credits on parent accounts when the school receives the funding.

Co-Curricular Music

Enrolment in co-curricular music is via a separate Agreement Form.

Music Lessons

Students in Classes 6 and 7 may enrol in additional co-curricular private or small group music lessons, beyond the compulsory primary instrumental music program.

- Additional Instrument - \$300/semester (half year)

Students in Classes 8 to 12 may enrol in co-curricular private or small group music lessons, beyond the compulsory secondary ensemble music program.

- 1st Instrument - \$300/semester (half year)
- 2nd Instrument - \$400/semester (half year)
- 3rd Instrument - \$500/semester (half year)

Co-curricular music lessons will be charged to accounts twice per year in Term 1 and Term 3.

Instrument Hire

Students may hire instruments through the school. Hire fees range from \$50 - \$150 per semester (half year) depending on the instrument type. Instrument hire will be charged to accounts twice per year in Term 1 and Term 3.

Extension/After-School Ensembles

Students in Classes 8 to 12 may enrol in extension / after school ensembles. Ensemble fees are \$150/semester and will be charged to accounts twice per year in Term 1 and Term 3.

Methods of Payment

Option 1: Annual Payment

School fees paid as an annual payment in full by Friday 27 January 2023 will be eligible for a 3.5% discount on tuition fees.

Option 2: Direct Debit Payment

Weekly payments will be spread over 42 weeks, starting by Monday 30 January 2023 and ending by Monday 20 November.

Fortnightly payments will be spread over 21 fortnights, starting by Monday 30 January 2023 and ending by Monday 20 November.

Monthly payments will be spread over 10 months, starting by Monday 30 January 2023 and ending by Monday 20 November.

Term payments will be spread over the four terms, and are to be paid in full, and due by the first Friday of each term.

It is important to contact the school Finance Department to discuss an alternate payment plan if you are unable to pay your fees by the due date, finance@noosasteiner.qld.edu.au

Please note: It is the parent's responsibility to set-up regular payment plans via direct debit with the school.

Bank charges incurred by the school for payments declined by the bank may be invoiced in your next statement.

Late Payment

The school cannot provide education to students where fees and levies remain unpaid. Unless prior arrangements are made with the school, fees that are overdue will incur late payment charges of \$100.00 (plus GST) per month from the date payment is due until fees are paid. The school may terminate the enrolment of a student if School Fees remain unpaid at the end of a term for which the fees are due. Fees outstanding after a student's enrolment ends for any reason will be referred to a debt collection agency. **Communication with the office is vital, if you are having difficulties paying your account by the date the finance office must be contacted.**

Sibling Discounts

While the costs of educating students remain the same, the school recognises that school fees can be more difficult for larger families. Fee concessions are offered to families with more than one child. The eldest child in the family who is enrolled at the school is considered the first child in every case and discounts apply in order of the first to the last child.

- **2nd child 10%**
- **3rd child 20%**
- **4th and subsequent children 30%**

Financial Assistance

A limited amount of concessional financial assistance may be available for families in short-term financial difficulty. Please contact the Principal to find out more.

Early Withdrawal from School

Ten (10) school-term weeks' notice, in writing, from the person responsible for the payment of school fees and addressed to the Principal is required for the intended withdrawal of a student from school. **Full fees are payable in lieu** if this notice is not provided.

Community Participation

Families who enrol at the Noosa Pengari Steiner School are asked to make a commitment to the school community by attending working bees and assisting at the annual Pengari Children's Festival. Your involvement is truly invaluable to the school and the students (as well as fun).

Fees Variation

It is the intention of the School Board that the fee levels set prior to the start of each school year will remain in force for the whole of the year. However, the right is reserved to change the level of fees during the year, if factors outside the control of the School Board impact significantly upon the cost of operating the school.
